

**ORDER ON MOTION FOR ENFORCEMENT AND CLARIFICATION OF DECREE OF
DIVORCE AND ORIGINAL PETITION FOR BREACH OF FIDUCIARY DUTY AND

On July 12, 2006 the Court considered the Motion for Clarification of Prior of DORIS J. HAGEN, Movant.

Appearances

Movant, DORIS J. HAGEN, appeared in person and through attorney of record, GARY A. GEAHM, and announced ready for trial.

Respondent, RAOUL HAGEN, appeared in person and through attorney of record, ROBERT S. THOMPSON, and announced ready for trial.

Proceedings

All matters of law and of fact were submitted to the Court, and the Court heard the evidence and considered the pleadings and argument of counsel.

Jurisdiction

The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties in this case. All persons entitled to citation were properly cited.

Record

The record of testimony was duly reported by the court reporter for the 150th Judicial District Court.

Findings

The Court finds that the prior order should be clarified as ordered below and that DORIS J. HAGEN and RAOUL HAGEN should be ordered to comply with the terms of this clarifying order.

Orders

IT IS ORDERED that the military retirement pay now being received by RAOUL HAGEN shall be divided according to the formula stated in the Original Decree of Divorce. The amount subject to this formula for division shall not include the amount awarded to RAOUL HAGEN as disability pay.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all terms of the prior order that are not clarified in this order shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS ORDERED that neither party shall pay attorney's fees, however, each party is ORDERED to pay their own expenses and costs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event of an appeal, the prevailing party shall be awarded attorney's fees, to be paid by the losing party, as follows:


- a. to the Court of Appeals, the sum of \$6,000.00
- b. in the event of a Petition for Review is filed in the Texas Supreme Court, an additional \$5,000.00
- c. in the event a Petition for Review is granted by the Texas Supreme Court an additional sum of \$3,000.00 is awarded.
